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3	WHEREAS, OCSEA grassroots leaders are at the core of
4	OCSEA's structure and are the foundation of the organization as a
5	whole; and
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7	WHEREAS, OCSEA and labor are facing unprecedented attacks
8	by groups like the Freedom Foundation and the Buckeye Institute to try
9	to get members to drop their union; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, specific actions like internal mobilization, have been
12	proven to help our members connect the dots and build union power,
13	increase the union membership, and strengthen political power; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, leadership development and skill training in internal
16	organizing will teach leaders how to effectively educate members about
17	the advantages of the union and the practical reasons why members
18	should join, and that solidarity is our greatest tool; and
19	

20	WHEREAS, these conversations and relationships that are
21	engendered, will help us hold the line against our adversaries, make the
22	ranks of our union stronger and build union capacity; now
23	
24	THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED OCSEA will work to ensure
25	leaders are well trained in internal mobilization, one-on-ones,
26	mentorship, and other skills that will help recruit new members, get more
27	members involved in the union, and keep the union strong; and
28	
29	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, OCSEA will make it a priority to
30	recruit new leaders and help them establish priorities, set goals, and
31	develop action plans; and
32	
33	BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED OCSEA is committed to developing
34	strong leaders that share the union values and mission to make the lives
35	of our members and our communities better.

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
