I am pleased to provide this report of our local's activities for April 2018.

The month started off with some amazing momentum around events to commemorate the work of Reverend Dr. King. AFSCME 3580 members led a project team that planned a 300+ attendee event at the Oregon Convention Center presented by Oregon AFSCME, Metro and Church of God in Christ (COGIC). The event brought speakers from faith, labor and community to talk about the work Dr. King did to fight for racial and economic justice and that we still have the same fight today. IBEW 48, Oregon Convention Center and AFSCME 328 (OHSU) provided donations or in-kind support for the event. Portland and Vancouver NAACP chapters, Coalition of Black Trade Unionists, Portland Jobs with Justice, KBOO and Street Roots also supported the event. Monies raised for the effort that exceed event costs will be used for a second, to-be-planned event that focuses on racial and economic justice and brings in emerging youth leaders. Many thanks and much love to Stacey Hopkins, Serin Bussel, Lake Thelan, Bonnie Shoffner, Enrique Vargas, Katie Hentges and so many other members and friends in the labor community who have helped bring together the events.

For our local, the biggest priorities in April continued to be:

- Negotiations with management on the impact of contracting out our jobs at the Oregon Zoo in the catering division and Cascade Grill
- Disparate treatment and working conditions for members at the Oregon Convention Center
- Building our member advocate (steward) team
- Support for candidates who support us and issues that face working people in our community.

We will be ramping up to support the Metro housing bond measure should the Metro Council refer it to the voters. Look for information on that soon!
