As such, we will not be able to conduct our e-board meetings virtually at this time, as we are not able to comply with #2* of the Policy for Conducting Audio and/or Video Teleconference Meetings of a Subordinate Body ([Appendix E of the AFSCME International Constitution](#)).

** 2. All equipment required to conduct the virtual meeting must be readily accessible, or made available, to all participating members.*

While we continue to adapt to the new telework culture during this public health emergency, we also need to remain in compliance with our constitutional guidelines. We will continue to research options to ensure access in case this COVID-19 state of emergency continues beyond May 2020.
