



**State and Local Fiscal Relief Distributions – Rough Estimates
March 20, 2020**

The following table provides a rough estimate of expected distributions to states. The estimate is based on each state’s share of FY 2017 state and local own-source general revenue, using the most recent fiscal year data available from the Census Bureau. States’ actual allocations would be determined by multiplying state and local own-source general revenue amounts for FY 2019 by 7 percent. The table below shows each state’s percentage of the nation’s total state and local own-source general revenue and that state’s share of \$175 billion. States would distribute a portion of funds to local governments based on those governments’ share of own-source revenue.
