
Jacquie Jones-Walsh Memorial Scholarship

A. Philip Randolph Institute: APRI is an alliance between labor and the civil rights movement. Today, it fights for racial equality and economic justice. (*Membership term: Jan - Dec*)

Asian Pacific American Labor Alliance: APALA is the nation's first national organization of AAPI workers. It focuses on advancing worker, immigrant and civil rights. (*Membership term: Jan - Dec*)

Coalition of Black Trade Unionists: CBTU is an independent voice for black workers within the labor movement. (*Membership term: Jan - Dec*)

Coalition of Labor Union Women: CLUW unifies union women to face shared concerns. The coalition focuses on action on issues important to women workers. (Membership term: Rolling membership)

Labor Council for Latin American Advancement: LCLAA represents 2 million Latino workers. The council organizes working people to protect the rights and expand the influence of Latinos. (Membership term: Jan - Dec, must renew each calendar year, membership pro rated from time of joining till end of calendar year)

Pride At Work: Pride@Work brings together the labor movement and the LGBTQ community in pursuit of social and economic justice. (Membership term: Rolling membership from join date)
