 - New Hire updates
 - Please communicate with how discussions & assessments are going with new hires
 - Potentially put NEO presentation back in negotiations
 - New HRIS system, to make math work, dues may be rounded, but no real change here
 - We don't know how many new employees are being contacted about ASFCME Local 517
 - Can get folders if you need to, don't have cards but can tell them to call <u>MemberLink</u> and sign a card digitally
 - Unclear on what format County wants us to use when talking about joining the Union since they took out the presentation for employee orientation
 - Database to keep track of these conversations (Membership Secretary) position vacant -cannot use county email for organizing purposes
 - need better structure around this
- 4. Business Rep. Report:
 - Due to a retirement and reshuffling at ASFCME, Suzanne Kocurek (long time Social Worker for Ramsey County) will be new Business Rep. starting June 1, 2018.
 - Live Streamed Gubernatorial Candidate Screening
 - Speculating that AFSCME is tabling endorsement again
 - Murphy agreed to drop out if ASFCME does not endorse, hoping that all candidates will abide by this
 - All support us, but we need to come together with one DFL candidate
 - CG meeting
 - Went really well, was a good way to make a personal connection with new employees or others who are not familiar with what Local 517 does
 - Assessments were completed

- Will work with new Rep. to update about members who will/can do assessments
- Will do more events like this in FL, Stillwater, Government Center
- Lost Timers looking to work with librarians for site visits
 - A.P. will do Stillwater and Oakdale
 - Have \$1,000 for this in budget
- 5. Old Business:
 - CG Meeting, went great, signed up 3 people, about 15 people showed
- 6. New Business:
 - AFSCME International Call to Convention (July 16-20), Boston, MA
 - L.F. wants to go, but is willing to save the budgeted money to spend on local solidarity
 - Need to do a mailer to nominate a delegate to go
 - Modifications; amendments to constitutions, resolutions, etc.
 - Elections taking place, delegates can bring per capita votes of other members
 - Per election rules in international constitution, have to do a mailing announcing the nominations for delegates for the convention
 - One delegate costs roughly 3-4k, money is budgeted along with mailing costs
 - Will do nomination at next meeting, if contested, it comes down to a vote at a general membership meeting
 - Mailing will be sent out next week
 - How many delegates are we authorized to send? (1 for every 25 members)
 - Pay delegate; max budgeted (\$3,000)includes airfare, lost-time, per diem and lodging
 - Keep what we have budgeted, if someone goes over, delegate pays out of pocket for the rest
 - M/S/C Not to send a delegate, R.R., N.A.
 - What happens to votes when nobody goes? (staff would go in place when there is a potential fight)
 - E-Board Meeting
 - Fourth Monday of the month falls on Memorial Day. E-board meeting tentatively rescheduled for May 30th may cancel, due to holiday
