- \Rightarrow Þ Discussed the MOA vote concerning layoffs and voted unanimously to accept the MOU. This only affects positions open now through 6/30/17.

- ⇒ ▷ Alison talked about temp positions and why not all temps across campus have to be gone before any permanent employees are laid off, it depends on the types of positions being eliminated and the work areas involved.
