

The state's current budget crisis is in large part a result of our state's inequitable tax code that relies on those with the least to pay the most.

Rather than rally support to fix what is the second-most unfair tax structure in the United States and ask the billionaires to pay more, Governor Ferguson has called for a "tax" on public workers: furloughs, 6 percent cuts at every state agency, a \$63 million dollar cut to higher education, and closing facilities and wards the most vulnerable depend on.

All of which would compound rather than combat the chaos and suffering coming from DOGE and Musk in D.C. Over 20k WFSE members' jobs are funded by federal dollars in some capacity. Countless Washingtonians will lose access to vital services they're receiving right now if these cuts go through.

If we don't more evenly spread the responsibility for funding vital state services now, we'll be paying for these cuts for generations. Tell your elected officials about your work, why it matters for Washingtonians, and why you deserve better.
